Responsibilities

Management

Employees

Follow all health and safety procedures, report hazards or unsafe conditions, and participate in safety training.

Health and Safety Representative

Oversee the health and safety program, conduct risk assessments, and ensure compliance with regulations.

Regular risk assessments will be conducted to identify potential hazards within our work environments, allowing us to implement effective measures to mitigate these risks. As part of our commitment to safety, safety procedures will be updated accordingly to reflect any changes in operations or regulations. By maintaining an ongoing process of risk evaluation, we ensure that our workplace remains as safe as possible for all employees, contractors, and visitors.

This policy will be communicated clearly to all employees, contractors, and visitors, with procedures put in place for effective implementation. We will monitor our performance through regular reporting, audits, inspections, and reviews, tracking performance metrics and taking corrective actions as necessary.

This policy will be reviewed regularly to ensure compliance with legal requirements and adoption of best practices.
